Minutes Tuesday October 13, 2009

In attendance: 27 people attending.

It was suggested that we might do some advertising next year.

The greeter and flower list for 2010 is close to completion and will be available soon.

For All Saints day on November 1, we will have communion and honor of those who died in the past year and a coffee hour following the service.

Plans are beginning for both Thanksgiving Sunday on November 22 and the Hanging of the Greens on December 6.

We have ongoing concern for Mark Taylor who continues to have health problems. Are there people in the congregation who could contact and visit him?

Ed has been asked by the Oneida Association to be a transitional consultant to the 1st Congregational Church of Phoenix. This would involve his being with them 1 Sunday per month for 6 to 8 months with Myrt Delaney filling our pulpit when he is gone. A motion was made by Anthony Dangler and seconded by Rick Lloyd that we allow this to take place and was passed.

Lawrence Gilley made the council aware of Community Tour on Saturday October 15. Ed has been unable to get in touch with Caroline Williams of Cooperative Extension to get more information. It seems too late to get much involvement for this year at this point.

Discussion should begin about finding people to serve on council in the coming year.

Womens meeting here on November 7. Painting of the non-sided portions of the church has been completed and paid for.

Trustees send a report that minor repairs to the boiler should be done by Sunday.

Myrt brought to our attention the desire of the Association to participate in the campaign to have ten churches combine to raise \$3,100 to drill a well in a village in Kenya. The idea has expanded to have Three Steeples, Deansboro and Trinity in Rome work together to donate money to drill a second well. A motion to accept this challenge was made by Mary Dickinson, seconded by Anthony Dangler and passed.

A motion was made that we ask Anthony Dangler to speak to the congregation about The Crop Walk which will take place on Sunday October 25 by Mary Dickinson and seconded by Rick Lloyd and passed.

Motion to adjourn made by Mary Lou Rosecants, seconded by Anthony Dangler and passed.
